The 12<sup>th</sup> Thailand Halal Assembly 2025 (THA 2025) is a premier international platform that brings together scholars, policymakers, industry leaders, entrepreneurs, and stakeholders from across the global halal ecosystem. THA 2025 is organized by the Halal Science Center, Chulalongkorn University (HSC-CU), in collaboration with the Central Islamic Council of Thailand (CICOT), the Halal Standard Institute of Thailand (HSIT), and the Standards and Metrology Institute for Islamic Countries (SMIIC), the Assembly reflects Thailand's continued commitment to advancing Halal science, innovation, and governance at both regional and international levels. THA 2025 will be held on 18–19 December 2025 at Al Meroz Hotel, Bangkok, in a hybrid format that combines onsite participation with online access, enabling broad global engagement.

Under the theme **“Green Halal: Beyond Sustainability,”** THA 2025 seeks to redefine the future of the Halal industry by integrating Halal principles with environmental responsibility, ethical production, and sustainable innovation. 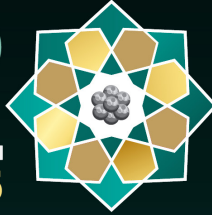

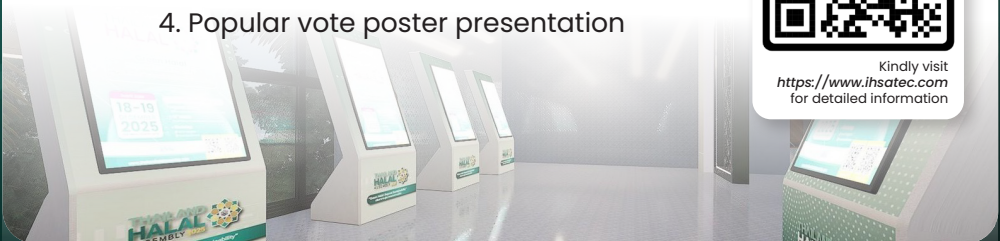

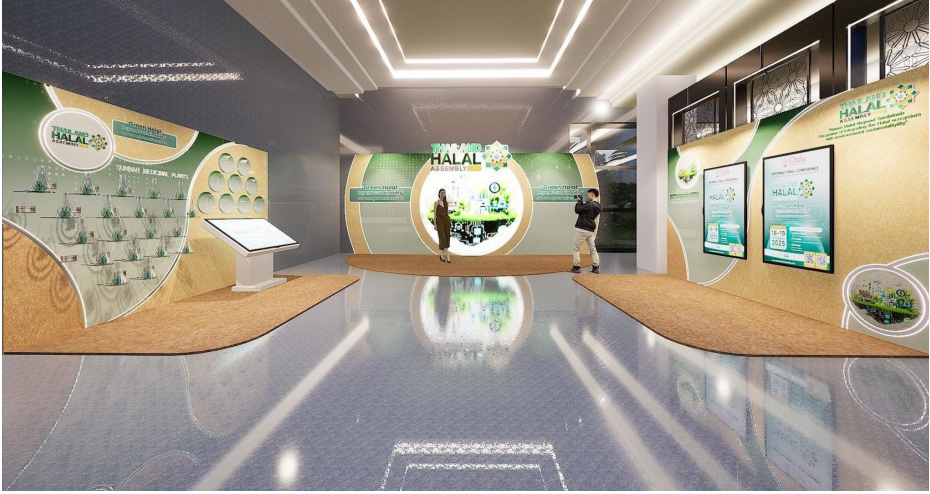

The exhibition comprises three key sections:

### 1. Green Halal

## Mass Transit Interchange Stations



Use this for official travel guides,

Here is a step-by-step breakdown you can come from different locations:

### By Airport Rail Link (Recommended)

This is the fastest route from both Suvarnabhumi Airport and downtown Bangkok. Station: Get off at Ramkhamhaeng Station.

From the Station: Take Exit 1 or 2. The hotel is approximately a 600-meter walk (about 8-10 minutes) or a quick motorcycle taxi ride.

### Connection from BTS/MRT

From BTS Skytrain: Take the BTS to Phaya Thai Station (N2) and transfer to the Airport Rail Link. From MRT Subway: Take the MRT to Phetchaburi Station (BL21) and transfer to the Airport Rail Link at Makkasan Station.

### For Taxi / Drivers

If attendees prefer to take a Grab or Taxi, Al Meroz Hotel, Ramkhamhaeng Road Soi 5, near Ramkhamhaeng Airport Link Station

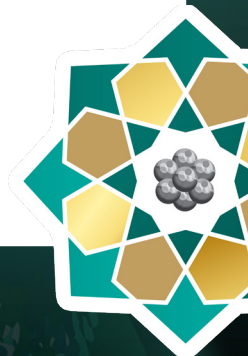

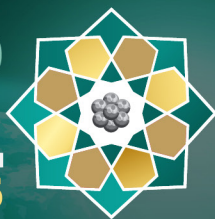
